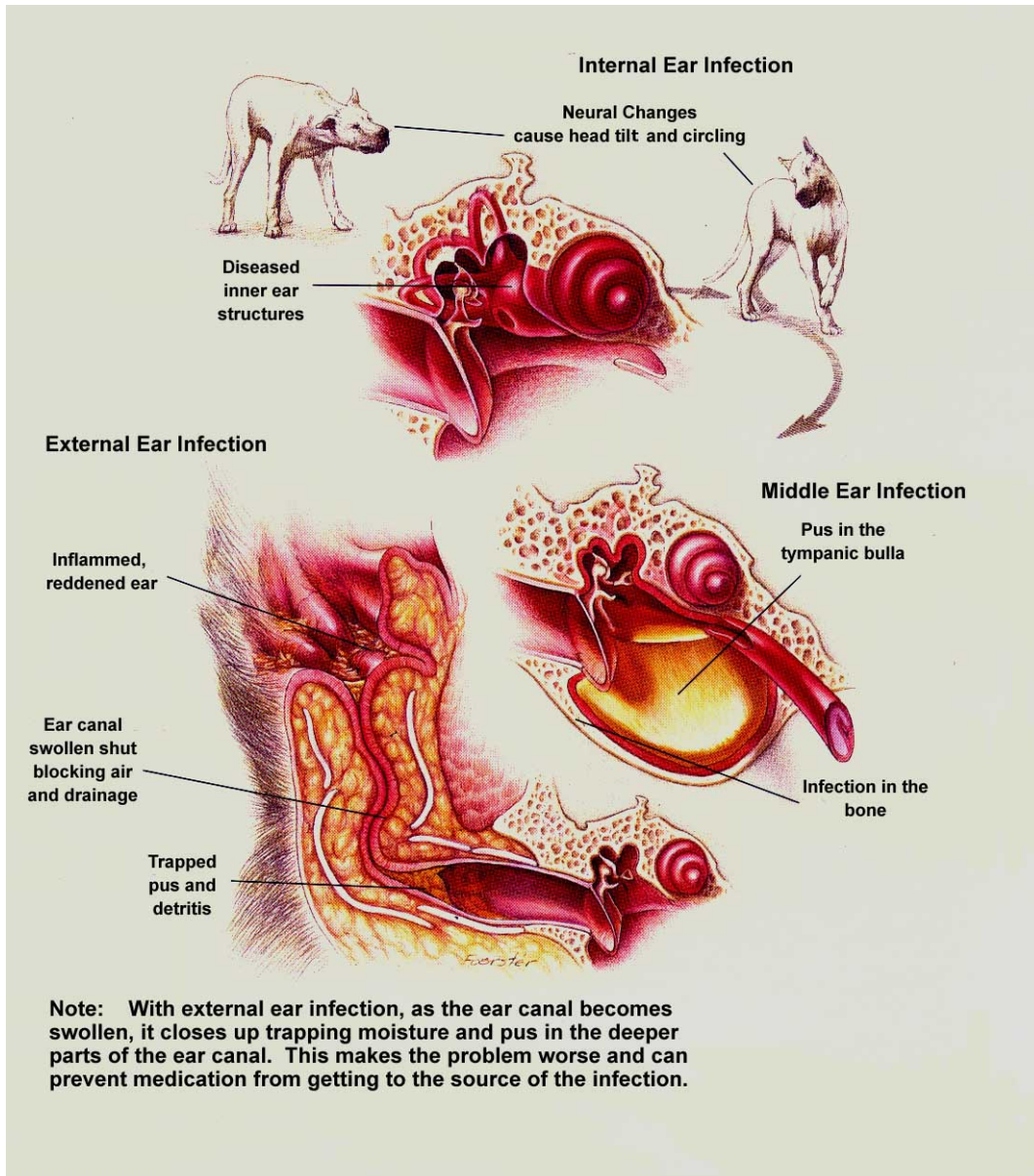


Canine Ear.

Notice the vertical canal and horizontal canal... Humans only have a horizontal canal allowing much more drainage and air flow. This is the reason dogs and cats have so many more ear infections than humans.



Canine And Feline Ear Care

Clean, odor-free, pale pink color and a minimal accumulation of wax are indications of healthy ears. Check your pet's ears regularly.

Signs of Ear Disease

- Unpleasant odor
- Excessive scratching and pawing of the ear and head
- Sensitivity to touch, often resulting from pain
- Constant tilting/shaking of the head to one side
- Black or yellowish discharge
- Redness or swelling of the ear flap or canal
- Changes in behavior like listlessness, depression or irritability
- Accumulation of dark brown wax
- Loss of balance or hearing and disorientation
- Bleeding or discharge resembling coffee grinds

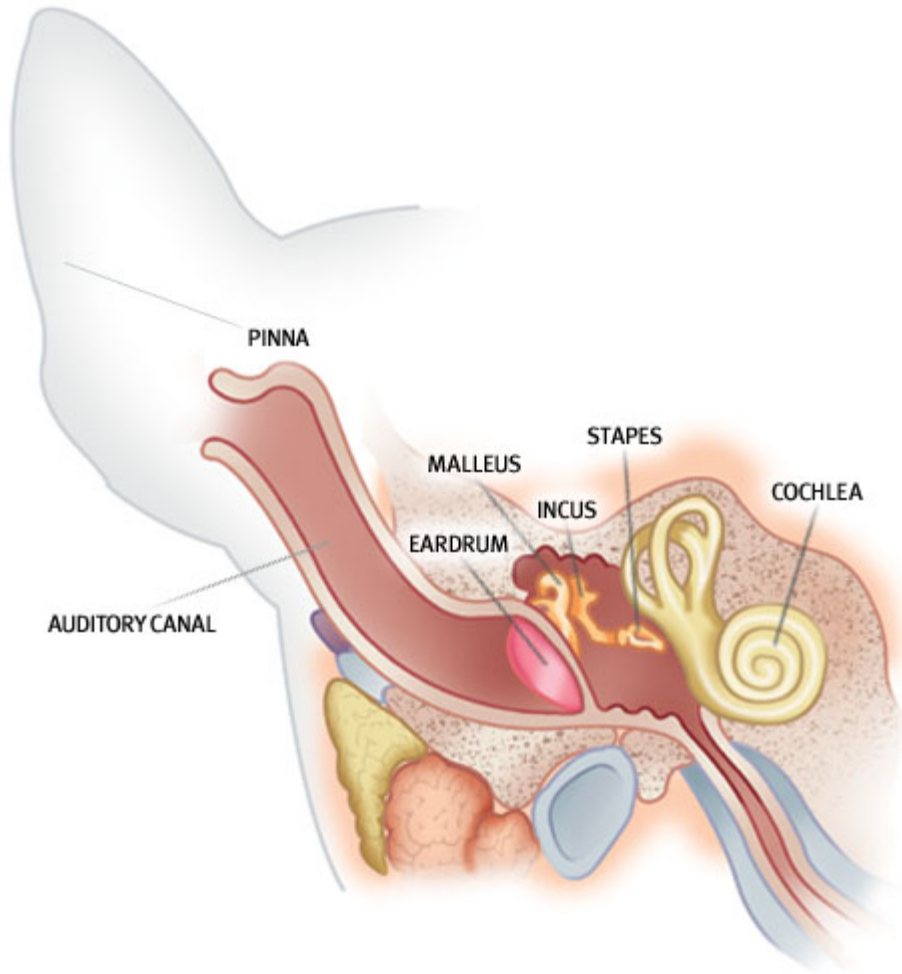
